

ORDINANCE # 467

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 355, "AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE COLLECTION OF SEWER SERVICE CHARGES,

CONNECTION (TAP-ON) FEES, USE PERMIT FEES, AND FINES AND PENALTIES FOR ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS FROM USERS OF THE PUBLIC SEWAGE TREATMENT SYSTEM" (as adopted February 4, 2003, and not amended heretofore)

WHEREAS, the cost to provide adequate operation, maintenance and debt service of the sewer system, as with all services, increases with inflation (at a minimum), and;

WHEREAS, the City's bond covenants require rates and charges that provide revenues sufficient to address all expenses, including debt service, and;

WHEREAS, To avoid permit violations and breaching of bond covenants the City must provide sufficient revenue to continue operating the sewer collection and treatment systems in compliance with all state and federal regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY the city of Cumberland, Kentucky as follows:

Section One: The sewer rate schedules, as set forth in ordinance number 355,

*PIGS a \$1.00 per month service charge included in the minimum bill not amended heretofore, are amended as follows:

Section Two: This amended rate shall apply to all users and rate calculations as stipulated in the rates, schedules and charges set forth in all rate ordinances and bond covenants of the City of Cumberland pertaining to the wastewater (sewer) collection and treatment systems.

Section Three: The rates in this amending ordinance shall become effective with the billing cycle which commences on May, 2019.
