ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF EDMONTON, KENTUCKY AMENDING RATES  
AND CHARGES FOR SEWER SERVICE PROVIDED BY THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Edmonton, Kentucky (the "City") proposes to finance the construction of Sewage Rehabilitation Project (the "Project") through the issuance of \$700,000 of the City's "Water Revenue and Sewer Revenue Bonds, Series of 2013, (the "Bonds") supplemented by a \$300,000 grant from the United States Department of Agriculture, Rural Development ("USDARD"), and, \$500,000 Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) and \$1,000,000 Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and

WHEREAS, the rate amendment is necessary to provide for the payment of all debt service on the Bonds and all Outstanding Bonds of the City and as required by USDARD in their Letter of Conditions to the City dated October 29, 2012;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY

COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF EDMONTON, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

1. That commencing with the billing period corresponding to the month of January 2013, the City's rates and charges for sewer service shall be as follows:

SEWER RATES WILL BE AT LEAST:

First	2,000 gallons @ \$15.35 - Minimum Bill
Next	8,000 gallons @ 5.40 - per 1,000 gallons
Next	5,000 gallons @ 4.30 - per 1,000 gallons
Next	5,000 gallons @ 3.25 - per 1,000 gallons
Next	5,000 gallons @ 2.20 - per 1,000 gallons
All over	25,000 gallons @ 1.70 - per 1,000 gallons

2. That all other rates and charges not specifically mentioned herein, including the water charges, shall remain as presently effective.

3. That all ordinances or parts thereof and resolutions of the City in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

4. That this Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.
