BULLITT COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT RESOLUTION NUMBER 2013 – 11A

WHEREAS, statutory enabling legislation allows the Bullitt County Sanitation District to levy, modify, or increase sewer rates in the District, and

WHEREAS, current operations in the Bullitt County Sanitation District with sewer usage fee collections of sewer usage at the current rate are insufficient to meet all ongoing operational costs of the sewer system and an operational loss has occurred through the lack of growth, the lack of ability to fund operations through revenue of new customers and new lines, and the enhanced need to repair old facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Bullitt County Sanitation District to adopt this Resolution permitting the Bullitt County Sanitation District to modify rates to reflect an increase or decrease by the annual Percentage increase or decrease in the Consumer Price Index¹ transpiring as of October 1 of the preceding calendar year.

NOW, THEREFORE, the published Consumer Price Index ¹ for October, 2013 is 0.9636% (October 2013 CPI of 233.546 vs. October 2012 CPI of 231.317).

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to KRS 220.510, with the Commissioners of the Bullitt County Sanitation District sets the Sewer Rates within the Bullitt County Sanitation District to become effective on or about January 1, 2014 (depending on the Louisville Water Company January meter reading schedule) as follows:

\$14.44 per month for the first 2,000 gallons of Usage and an additional Consumption Charge of \$4.62 per month for each additional 1,000 gallons of usage.

The Tap Fee per Single Family Residential Unit and/or Individual Apartment Unit shall be \$3,000.00.

The Tap Fee for Commercial and/or Industrial Users shall be \$3,000.00 per Residential Equivalent. A Residential Equivalent shall be defined as 6,000 gallons of usage per month.

The District has determined that certain classes of customers may require their monthly billing to be adjusted to a rate not currently represented by the above. At such time, the District at its regular meeting shall make a determination as to the monthly rate and notify the Louisville Water Company of such monthly billing service charge.
