

ORDINANCE 1060-2019

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF NICHOLASVILLE, KENTUCKY, CHAPTER 23, UTILITIES, ARTICLE III. RATES AND CHARGES, SECTION 23-22, WASTEWATER USER CHARGES, (D) SEWER RATES.

WHEREAS, the City of Nicholasville provides retail wastewater service to customers both inside and outside the corporate limits:

WHEREAS, the Board of Commission of the City of Nicholasville in the exercise of its fiduciary duties and responsibilities must now, in consideration of increases in the water utility's revenue requirements, adjust the monthly service charge/wastewater rates charged to customers;

WHEREAS, Section 23-22 (d) of the Nicholasville Code of Ordinances is amended as follow:

(d) *Sewer rates.*

- (1) Rates and charges based on the surcharge method.
- (2) Volume charges for residential customers are based upon the average monthly metered water consumption for the previous winter quarter period (months of December, January, and February). Volume charges for other than residential customers are based upon one hundred (100) percent of the months metered water usage.
- (3) Sewer rates shall be effective as follows:

(4) If a residential, commercial, institutional, or industrial user has a consumptive use of water, or in some other manner, uses water which is not discharged into the wastewater collection system, the user charge for that contributor may be based on readings of a wastewater meter(s) or separate water meter(s) installed and maintained at the user's expense.

(5) Any person who transports septic tank, seepage pit or cesspool contents, liquid industrial waste or other batch liquid industrial waste or other batch liquid waste and wishes to discharge such waste at the Jessamine Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) shall first have a valid Waste Hauler Permit. All applicants for a Waste Hauler Permit shall complete the application form, pay the appropriate fee and receive a copy of the city's regulations governing the discharge of liquid wastes from septic hauler trucks. All persons receiving such permits shall agree, in writing to abide by all applicable provisions of their waste hauler permit. The WWTP Superintendent will certify the capacity of each tank before issuance of a waste hauler permit.

The discharge of all hauled wastewater wastes must be performed at the Jessamine Creek WWTP on normal working days (Monday through Friday) 6:45 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. A Hauled Wastewater Discharge Manifest certifying the origin of all waste must accompany each load. Hauled wastewater is subject to sampling at the discretion of WWTP staff based on information recorded on the Manifest. All monitoring/testing costs will be billed to the Waste Haulers as described hereinafter.

The Hauled Wastewater Discharge Manifest must contain the following: Hauler (Company Name), Permit Number, Gallons of Waste, Generator Waste, Address of Generator of Waste, Date & Time Loaded, Hauler's Signature, Date & Time Disposed of at WWTP and WWTP Operator's Signature. Failure to accurately record every discharge or falsification of data will result in revocation of the waste hauler permit or be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for each occurrence.

Fees: Annual Per Truck Discharge Permit \$50.00

The Septic Waste Discharge Rate will be set by the Director in recognition of industry accepted cost of service principles and prevailing market conditions.

Waste Haulers will be billed by the City of Nicholasville through miscellaneous invoicing once per month. Provided a sight glass is mounted in the middle of a truck's tank, the capacity of the tank will be deemed either half of a load or a full load.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption, execution and publication.
