**ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_ 3 -2012**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, KENTUCKY, AMENDING ORDINANCE 11-2005 AND INCREASING CHARGES FOR THE USE AND SERVICES OF A MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM FOR PERSONS LIVING WITHIN THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, KENTUCKY; ESTABLISHING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND OTHER MATTERS.**

**WHEREAS**, the cost of supplying water services to the residents of the City of Worthington, Kentucky have increased; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Worthington, Kentucky finds it necessary to raise additional revenue in order to support the municipal water systems:

**NOW BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Worthington, Kentucky, as follows:

**SECTION 2:** That the City of Worthington, Kentucky water usage rates for those persons living within the city limits of the City of Worthington, Kentucky shall be as follows:

- First 2,000 gallons of water used - \$20.94 flat rate.
- For usage of 2,001 gallons to 6,000 gallons, the rate shall be \$.004 per gallon used.
- For usage of 6,001 gallons and above, the rate shall be \$.0025 per gallon used.
- Rates for all commercial usage shall be at \$.006 per gallon, regardless of volume.

**SECTION 3:** That the minimum water bill for all water users living within the city limits of the City of Worthington, Kentucky, regardless of usage will be no less than \$20.94 with additional water usage being charged on a scale set forth in Section 2.

**SECTION 4:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

**SECTION 5:** That all ordinances in conflict herewith are specifically hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict only.

**SECTION 6:** That each section and each sentence of this ordinance is enacted separately and the invalidity and/or unconstitutionality of any one particular sentence and/or section shall not affect the validity and/or constitutionality of any other sentence and/or section.

**SECTION 7:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
