

ORDINANCE # 009-12

AN ORDINANCE REVISING THE RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF AND THE SERVICES RENDERED BY THE MUNICIPAL WATER AND SEWER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF MUNFORDVILLE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Munfordville, Kentucky (the "City"), has determined that is necessary to increase the existing monthly water and sewer rates,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF MUNFORDVILLE, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Revised Monthly Water Rates. That the rates and charges for water service furnished by the City are hereby revised as follows:

MONTHLY WATER RATES AND CHARGES.

- A. Customer Charge. The minimum water bill shall be \$10.00 per month. Each active water customer will pay this customer charge regardless of water usage.
- B. Meter Rates for Water Usage in Addition to Customer Charge. The following Metered charges shall be made for each 1,000 gallons or less of water consumption per month to customers of all size water connections:

<u>Gallons of Water per Month</u>	<u>Charge per 1,000 Gallons</u>
0 gallons (Customer Charge)	\$10.00 minimum bill
First 2,000 gallons	\$2.50 per 1,000 gallons
Next 48,000 gallons	\$6.00 per 1,000 gallons
Next 50,000 gallons	\$5.00 per 1,000 gallons
All over 1000,00 gallons	\$4.25 per 1,000 gallons

Section 2. Revised Monthly Sewer Rates. That the rates and charges for sewer service furnished by the City are hereby revised as follows:

MONTHLY SEWER RATES AND CHARGES.

- A. Customer Charge. The minimum sewer bill shall be \$10.00 per month. Each active sewer customer will pay this customer charge regardless of water usage.

B. Meter Rates for Sewer Usage in Addition to Customer Charge. The following metered charges shall be made for each 1,000 gallons or less of water consumption per month to customers of all size water connections:

<u>Gallons of Water per Month</u>	<u>Sewer Charge per 1,000 Gallons</u>
0 gallons (Customer Charge)	\$10.00 minimum bill
First 2,000 gallons	\$2.50 per 1,000 gallons
All over 2,000 gallons	\$6.00 per 1,000 gallons

Section: 3 Multiple Users on One Meter. Where two or more tenants or occupants (of different rental units) of property, including duplexes, apartment houses, mobile home parks, trailer parks or other multi-unit premises are served by a single water meter, the rates and charges for use of the water and sewer system to each tenant or occupant shall be computed by dividing the number of gallons of water registered by such single meter by the number of customers being served by such meter and then applying the result thus obtained to the water rate schedule set out in Section 1 above, and the sewer rate scheduled set out in Section 2 above to arrive at the monthly water and sewer bill for each tenant or occupant. Each tenant or occupant shall be separately billed unless the owner or operator of the property has agreed with the City to pay the total monthly water and sewer bill for such property. In no event shall the monthly water and sewer bill applicable to each tenant or occupant be less than the minimum rates stipulated in Sections 1 and 2 above.

Section: 4 Severability. That if any clause, provision, paragraph or section of this Ordinance be ruled void or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, the Remainder thereof is intended to be enacted and shall be in full force and effect notwithstanding.


Section: 5 All Former Provisions in Conflict Repealed: Effective Date of Ordinance.

That all orders, ordinances, motions or parts thereof, insofar as same may be in conflict herewith, are repealed, and this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, Approval and publication as provided by law.


