Water Rate Resolution

Effective July 1, 2021

Section 1: This Resolution shall replace and supersede any and all previous rates as they pertain to water treated and distributed by the Barbourville Utility Commission.

Section 2: Each customer of the water system shall pay a surcharge of **\$1.28** per month in addition to the Customer Service Charge. This surcharge shall be designated as **Corps of Engineers** on the monthly bill and is a result of the Barbourville Utility Commission being forced to pay for water withdrawn from Laurel River Lake. This charge shall remain in effect until such time as the Barbourville Utility Commission is no longer forced to pay the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. This surcharge is subject to increase or decrease depending on the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

Section 2: Each customer of the water system located inside the city limits shall have a separate water meter and shall pay a monthly service charge based upon the size of the meter as follows:

<u>Size of Water Meter</u>	<u>2021 Rate</u>
¾ " meter	\$9.08
1" meter	\$16.03
2" meter	\$29.96
3" meter	\$57.82
4" meter	\$113.52

Section 3: Each customer of the water system located outside the city limits shall have a separate water meter and shall pay a monthly service charge based upon the size of the meter as follows:

<u>Size of Water Meter</u>	<u>2021 Rate</u>
3/4" meter	\$12.80
1" meter	\$22.46
2" meter	\$41.81
3" meter	\$80.49
4" meter	\$157.86
Larger than 4" shall be by contract	

Section 4: Each water customer located inside the city limits shall pay the following for water:

	<u>2021 Rate</u>
Per 1000 gallons	\$2.97

Section 5: Each water customer located outside the city limits shall pay the following for water:

	<u>2021 Rate</u>
Per 1000 gallons	\$4.22

Section 6: Each water customer located in the Rural Areas (as defined as the Richland Water District) shall pay the following for water:

	<u>2021 Rate</u>
Per 1000 gallons	\$5.44

Section 7: In addition to the above rates, on July 1 of each year the Utility Commission may adjust rates based upon the Consumer Price Index(CPI) for the preceding year. Documentation for the CPI shall be available from the U.S. Department of Labor
