

CITY OF AUBURN, KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE 2013-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2007-01, A SCHEDULE OF RATES, FEES, AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF AND SERVICES RENDERED BY THE AUBURN WATER AND SEWER SYSTEMS OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, KENTUCKY AND HEREWITH TO THE EXTENT OF THAT CONFLICT ONLY, WITH SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF AUBURN, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1

- A. There is hereby established a revised schedule of rates, fees, and charges, that will be collected from users upon each lot, parcel, building, or premise for the use of services rendered by the City of Auburn Water and Sewer System in Auburn, Kentucky, a charge based upon the following rates:

Water rates:

First 1,200 gallons	\$12.42 <u>14.82</u> minimum bill
Next 28,800 gallons	\$9.10 <u>10.86</u> per 1,000 gallons
Next 70,000 gallons	\$7.74 <u>9.24</u> per 1,000 gallons
Over 100,000 gallons	\$6.46 <u>7.70</u> per 1,000 gallons

Sewer rates:

The sewer rate is 88.5% of the total water usage charge.

- B. Water and/or sewer bills are due on the 5th day of each calendar month. There will be a late charge of 10% of the outstanding bill applied to all bills that are not paid when due. Any bill that remains due and outstanding on the 15th day of the month will result in the disconnection of that service.
- C. Any service that is disconnected under the provision of paragraph B above shall be charged a \$50.00 reconnect fee payable before services are reinstated.
- D. The cash deposit for water/sewer services shall be as follows: Owner-occupant of a service location shall pay a \$100.00 deposit. Non-owner-occupant shall pay a \$200.00 deposit. A \$35.00 cut-on fee shall apply when a service is connected.
- E. Beginning with bills becoming due on or after January 5, 2008 an annual CPI increase of 3% on the above rates will automatically be incurred. The Auburn City Council may vote on a lesser percentage for the increase at its discretion.

SECTION 2

The foregoing revised schedule of rates and charges for the use of services rendered by the City of Auburn Water and Sewer System shall become effective for the collection for all water and sewage bills becoming due on or after ~~March 5, 2007~~ January 5, 2013.

SECTION 3


Any and all Ordinances, or parts thereof, which are in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.
